

GREAT TEAM OPPORTUNITIES IN CAMBODIA !!!

Be part of an exciting and pioneering ministry in Northern Cambodia – there are unique opportunities for short-term practical teams to help complete the fit-out of the new Hope Training Centre in Stung Treng.

Who we need:

- **4 Builders**
- **4 Plasterers**
- **4 Tilers**
- **Interior painters (as many as possible)**
- **Landscapers/gardeners (as many as possible)**

When we need:

In the time frame from early October until mid December 2016, for at least one week up to three weeks per person. Plus there is opportunity to visit Angkor Wat - one of the wonders of the ancient world.

Stung Treng (ST) is at the new strategic regional crossroads of Thailand, Laos and Vietnam. It could easily develop into a major hub for human trafficking and drugs, but Cambodian Christian leaders have a vision that instead it becomes a centre of Good News, hope and transformation. ST and the surrounding provinces are some of the most unreached and needy areas of Cambodia, and over the last few years Asian Outreach Cambodia, along with New Zealand partners, has established a pioneering base there. Working alongside locals they are involved in development of agriculture, education and clean water, plus have seen the first churches ever planted in the provinces. **For more information see aocam.org**

To assist in breaking the poverty cycle, we especially need to train young people in relevant skills so they can participate in the rapid development coming. The Hope Training Centre will be key in this breakthrough – training thousands for construction, agriculture, tourism, computers, English and leadership. Once completed the 700sq m building will also be used for church and community events, government meetings and accommodation for teams.

The initial construction phase is completed and now we need to fit out the interior of the building. We need capable and enthusiastic people to work alongside our local team to achieve this, and be part of investing into the future of a nation. Depending on length of time staying in Cambodia, the cost of trip including flights, accommodation, food, transport etc should be no more than \$3000 per person.
